Supporting Information Technology solutions and best practice sharing within Public Sector communities

The Security Cooperation Program Collaboration Portal (SCPCP) provides a “ready to use” portal that the SCP participant hosts for internal management of security incident response. SCP participants now have the ability to drive Computer Incident Response Information, solutions and best practice sharing within their constituencies and outreach communities.

SCPCP consists of community-focused templates and tools, as well as customized content on top of the out-of-the-box collaboration capabilities of SharePoint 2007. A self-hosted solution, SCPCP gives the agency the responsibility of content creation, maintenance, management, and installation.

SCPCP use is intended for:

- Sharing security response related information
- Collaborating between teams in the area of security incident response
- Applying agency branding
- Applying other templates
- Adding enhancements
- Customizing to meet an agency's needs
